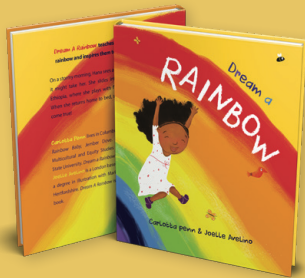

Daydreamers Press is a small, Black woman owned business with a focus on creating multicultural books, media, and related programming, especially for children.

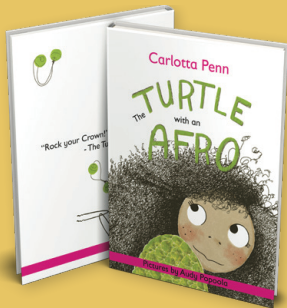
